Number of pupils by school type



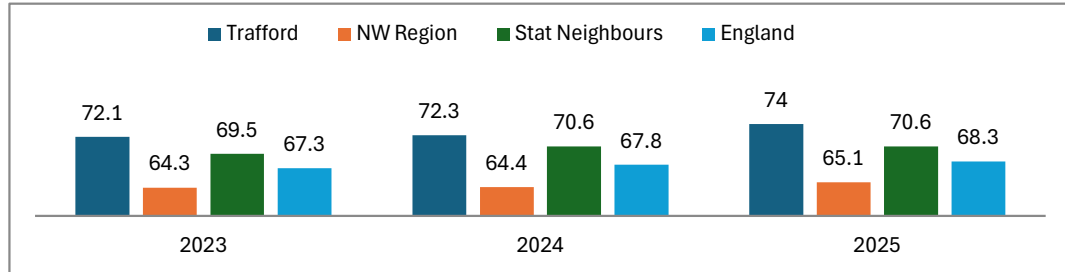

Percentage of pupils achieving GCSEs in both English and Mathematics (Basics)

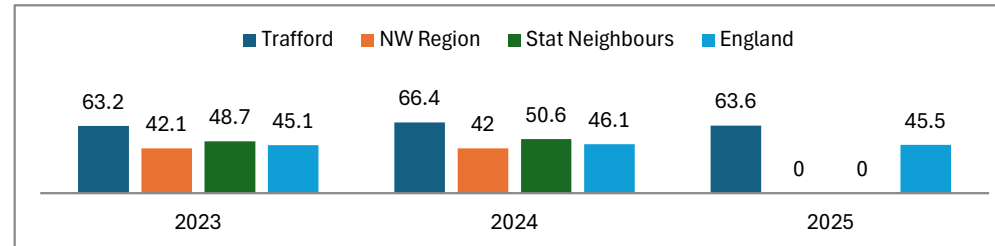

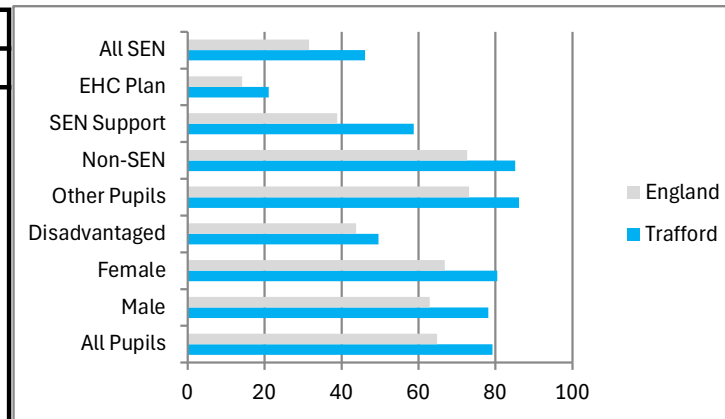


Percentage of pupils achieving a strong pass (9-5)
